River Flooding Continues Today - Unsettled Weather Persists into Next Week

KEY POINTS

- Flood Warnings: Oak Creek at Cornville through 8:00 PM Thursday. Wet & Dry Beaver Creek and West Clear Creek through 11 AM Thursday. Verde River near Clarkdale through 2 PM Thursday. Verde River from Camp Verde to the East Verde River until 11 PM Thursday.
- Snow levels around 6500 feet this morning, with light additional accumulation mainly <1 inch, except 1-3 inches higher elevations of Chuska Mountains.
- Unsettled pattern continues with additional rain/snow chances Sunday into next week.






Current Flood Watches, Warnings, and Advisories




Oak Creek - Sedona
