Declaration Of Local Emergency

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §26-311 authorizes the Mayor of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona or his/her designee to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the Town of Camp Verde is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity; and

WHEREAS, the unusually strong flood occurring on *March 15, 2023* and lasting through *March 23, 2023*, and the damages resulting therefrom, have caused extensive destruction to private property and to the many public facilities, streets, and roads within the Town of Camp Verde; and

WHEREAS, the flood has resulted in a condition of extreme peril to the health and safety of many citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Town of Camp Verde is authorized by resolution to declare a Local Emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby declared that an emergency now exists in the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona; and it is further ordered that during the existence of said emergency, local government agencies assigned emergency roles in the Town of Camp Verde Disaster Plan are an Emergency Organization and the Town of Camp Verde Disaster Plan is hereby activated and in effect until further notice.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said local emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this Town shall be those prescribed by state law and by ordinances and resolutions of the Town of Camp Verde. Citizens are urged to cooperate with this emergency declaration and, to every degree possible, abide by the safety announcements, advisories, restrictions established by the Town, by Yavapai County, and by the State of Arizona and to cooperate with the community's public safety agencies and emergency services personnel.
