The Children's Library is dedicated to providing a fun, safe learning environment; a place where children can create, explore, and ultimately, fall in love with reading!

Standards of Behavior:

When using the Children's Library, you are expected to behave in a manner that does not interfere with others' ability to enjoy library resources and services.

Laughter, play and talking in normal voices is fine, but running, jumping, shouting or prolonged crying is disruptive to other library patrons.

- Children must be supervised by a responsible caregiver at all time
- All liquids must be in a spill-proof container with a secure lid
- Food is not permitted on the Children's Outdoor Patio
- Dirty diapers must be placed in a restroom trash can
- No running or horseplay
- When Library programs are taking place, you are welcome to join the activity or relocate to another area in the library (if available) or outside.

Resources:

- Early Literacy computers with programs designed for parents and children together
- WiFi laptops and tablets
- Legos, wood blocks, and other toys
- Boardgames and puzzles
- Interactive toys, puppets, and dinosaurs
- Brain Boxes with age-specific early literacy activities
- Quilts for tummy time
- Activity Kits for outdoor play at the park

When you use the Children's Library spaces and resources, please clean up after yourself and your children. Toys should be put back on the shelf and books stacked neatly. Laptops, iPads, kits and craft supplies must be returned to the library staff.

We understand that accidents happen. If you or your child experiences a spill or another accident, please tell us so we can help with the cleanup.
