Report from Library Director, Kathy Hellman: I would like to bring you attention to two library staff members who have done an outstanding job in helping us out since our Youth Services Librarian, Nadia Torabi, resigned – Zack Garcia and Janell Leland. Zack, our Teen Library Specialist stepped in to help in areas he probably never thought he would, like school tours and kids Code Club. Janell, our part-time Children's Library Clerk has kept up with regular Children's programs like story time, craft nights, movie matinees, and regularly interacts with children and families in the afternoons and evenings. Both Zack and Janell are great examples of team players with helpful customer service attitudes and I appreciate their willingness to go the extra mile.

Report from Library Specialist, Carson Ralston: Northern Arizona Healthcare provided another free Health Screening at the library and had their best turnout since they have been doing the "Know Your Numbers" screenings at the library - 33 people! It's great to see the wonderful nurses from Northern Arizona Healthcare enjoy the services they provide, you can tell they love helping people! They will be returning on March 27th for another free non-fasting health screening for diabetes, cholesterol, and blood pressure.
