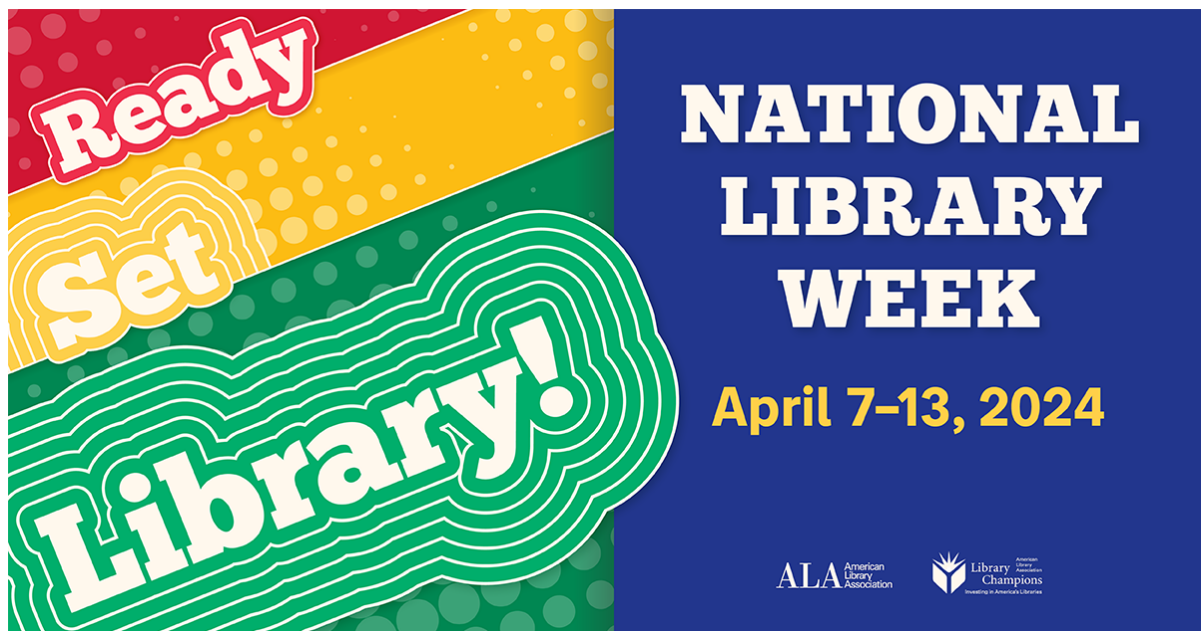
Camp Verde TAC Tree Sale

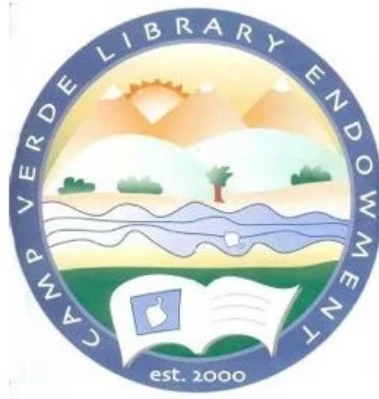


Local Quilters Donate Quilt

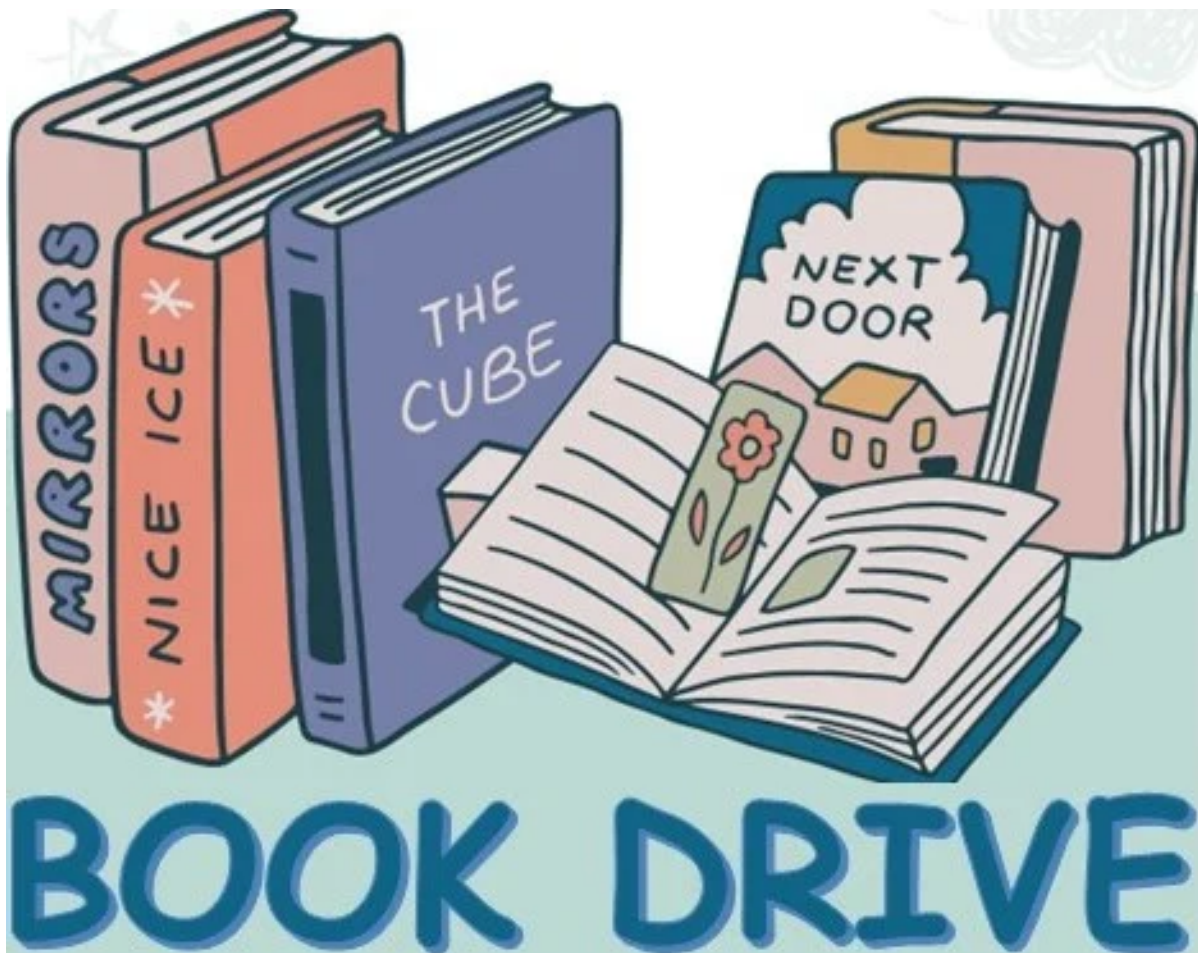


Camp Verde Library Endowment
