Background Information:

The Town of Camp Verde is committed to ensuring the safety and preparedness of its community members and employees. As part of this commitment, we are implementing the ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) Active Shooter Response Program. The ALICE program provides a proactive approach to active shooter response training, designed to increase the chances of survival during such critical incidents by emphasizing awareness, preparation, and evidence-based tactics.

Why is this Training Occurring with Council?

This training session with the Town Council is occurring to enhance understanding of the ALICE program and to ensure that our town leaders are equipped with the knowledge to respond effectively in the event of an active shooter situation. Training Council members aligns with our broader objective of community-wide preparedness and allows them to better support the ongoing implementation of safety protocols within Camp Verde.

Program Overview:

The ALICE program has been implemented in various sectors across Camp Verde, including local schools and emergency response teams. The program has been widely adopted throughout Arizona and has shown tangible improvements in response and survival rates during active shooter incidents. Following a successful presentation to the Camp Verde Unified School District Board and subsequent training sessions with school staff, we are bringing this crucial training to Town Council members and town employees. Our internal ALICE instructors have made significant progress since the program's introduction in 2023, despite earlier delays. We continue to build upon these efforts to ensure all facets of our community are well-prepared.

Empower individuals to participate in their own survival until help arrives.

ALICE Training* empowers individuals to participate in their own survival using proactive, options-based response strategies in the face of violence. The program is designed to ensure anybody can employ the strategies — young, old, male or female. Individuals do not have to be police officers or military-trained to survive a violent critical incident.

Communication Strategy



Alert is your first notification of danger. It involves recognizing signs of danger and receiving information about the danger from others. It can be as simple as accepting the announcement about an intruder or hearing the sound of a gunshot.

Response Option



Lockdown: If evacuation is not a safe option, barricade entry points. Use items near you to fortify the entry points to make it difficult for anyone to enter. Prepare to evacuate or spread out in the room and prepare to counter, if necessary.

Communication Strategy



Inform: Communicate real-time information about the violent intruder's location. Use clear and direct language via any communication means possible. Do not use code words, and relay as much information as you can so those involved are empowered to act as the situation requires.

Response Option



Counter: When in close proximity to the violent intruder, create noise and movement, using distraction to reduce the shooter's ability to shoot accurately. Counter is not fighting. Counter focuses on distraction and control techniques that leverage strength in numbers and the element of surprise.

Response Option



Evacuate: When safe to do so, run from danger, using non-traditional exits if necessary. Rally points should be predetermined and included in drills.

Remember, ALICE strategies are not sequential. Individuals are trained to choose based on their proximity to danger. There are no guarantees in a violent critical incident. As in most other emergency situations, the more you prepare, the better your chances of survival.


