## PRELIMINARY DRAFT Property Tax Timeline Election date 05-19-2015

To establish a primary property tax, a city or town must present the proposed levy to the voters at an election on the third Tueday in May. The ballot must state the amount to be raised by primary property taxes in the first year such a tax is imposed. The ballot must also state that this amount will be the base for determining levy limitatins for the Town in subsequent years

Post a notice on the Town Website at least 60 days before the Council votes to place the proposal to impose a property tax on the ballot and that the authority to impose the tax is specified in ARS 42-17056				02/18/2015	1			
1. Council passes a resolution ordering the election to be held at the regular voting places. The order must state that the election is to establish a primary property tax and the election must be held not less than thirty nor more than one hundred fifty days from the date of order.		04/19/2015						12/20/2014

3. Five Copies of the election order are posted in public places at least twelve days before the election	05/07/2015
