Other projects in Community Development are in the planning stages and are not public information as of yet. In the next 12 months more building is expected. Lichty asked how many new businesses will be income producing for the town? Foreman stated all projects are in the planning stage.

There was discussion regarding possible sales tax revenue. Foreman stated he has been in Camp Verde since 1992 and Camp Verde and he expects the economy will be taking off.

Buchanan asked how far the sewer expansion is going to go along state route 260 on the West side of I-17. Buchanan requested Foreman to check with Troy Odell regarding expansion of sewer and bring it back to the next meeting.
