ORDINANCE 2000-A164

A ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA ESTABLISHING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS AND TERM LIMITS FOR BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, Section 4-1 and following provisions of the code of the Town of Camp Verde now provide for qualifications, organization, duties, and general meeting procedures for boards and commissions of the Town, and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the public to require residency of members of all boards and commissions within the Town corporate boundaries, and to fix term limits.

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 4-1-B of the Town Code is amended by adding the following: Any member of a board or commission appointed by the Council shall reside within the corporate limits of the Town. If a member holding a position relocates outside of Town limits, other than within 90 days from the end of the appointed term, he or she shall resign from the board or commission.
- 2. Section 4-1-C of the Town Code is amended by adding the following: Persons appointed to a position on a board or commission of the Town shall be limited to two full consecutive terms in office on the same commission. If they have not been appointed for (2) years following the end of their last consecutive term, they are then re-eligible to serve. If no other applicants are available the Council may waive the requirements of this paragraph.
- 3. Resolution 99-429 is hereby voided and superseded by this ordinance.
