

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA AMENDING ORDINANCE 87-A23 BY APPROVING
THE MINING ORDINANCE

The Town Council of the Town of Camp Verde hereby orders as follows:

I. The Town Council hereby finds as follows:

- A. The Mining Ordinance was requested by the Town Council in order to regulate mining operations within the Town limits.
- B. The proposed Ordinance was reviewed by the Planning Commission on February 6, 1992 and by the Town Council on May 6, 1992 in public hearings that were advertized and posted according to state law.
- C. The proposed Ordinance will not constitute a threat to the health, safety, or welfare of the general public and should be approved in order to ensure the orderly growth and development of the Town of Camp Verde.

II. The Town Council of the Town of Camp Verde hereby adopts the Mining Ordinance as contained in and declared a public record in Resolution 92-180.

III. Penalty: Any person who fails to comply with any provision of this ordinance, or uses property in violation of any provision of the ordinance or a permit issued herein, shall be guilty of a petty offense for the first offense, and a misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense as to the same property or activity, with each day the property or activity is not in compliance constituting a separate offense. "Person" includes the property owner, occupant, agent, or any person having control over the use of the property. Enforcement of this ordinance may also be pursuant to Council action under 9-462.05, as amended."
