AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUING PERMITS FOR CASUAL BUSINESS OPERATIONS IN THE TOWN, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA:

Section I. Application. This ordinance shall govern all casual business sales and operations within the Town limits. "Casual business operations" include temporary sales and displays by street vendors, craft shows, fair booths, and similar operations, usually associated with a special event or holiday. This ordinance does not apply to garage sales, auctions, sidewalk sales, student fund raising sales, bake sales or swap meets. No permit shall be issued for a period longer than three (3) consecutive days.

<u>Section II</u>. <u>Procedure</u>. All operators of booths or vendor displays or other casual business operations shall, prior to setting up a display area:

- a. Obtain the written permission of the property owner, and tenant if any, for the operation.
- b. Obtain any necessary health or other regulatory permits required by law
- c. Complete an application for a Casual Business Permit with the Town, including describing the nature of the operations, name, address and driver's license of the owner of the business, licenses of any vehicles to be used in or near the display area, and other information required by the Town Marshal to ensure proper origin of the goods and services to be offered for sale, and the responsibility of the proprietor.
- d. Pay any fees required as follows:
 - 1. \$1 per event for service clubs and non-profit organizations
 - 2. \$25 per event for all other casual business operations
 - 3. The Council by resolution may adjust the fees for casual business operations

<u>Section III.</u> <u>Operations</u>. The casual business operations shall be conducted within the following guidelines, enforceable by the penalty provisions of this ordinance, which shall be delivered to all applicants:

- a. The permit will be for the location and hours of operation specified, and will not be transferable
- b. The permit will be prominently displayed at the site at all times
- c. The operator will not operate the booth or site in such a manner that unreasonable noise or the nature of the display interferes with other operators or the program for the event, and shall maintain the booth or site in a cleanly manner
- d. The permit may be terminated for failure of the operator to abide by the procedures and requirements herein, and forfeiture of a permit for cause may result in denial of a permit in the future by the proprietor.
- e. The Town Council may impose additional requirements for operations as to a particular event.

<u>Section IV.</u> <u>Restrictions</u>. The Town Clerk shall not issue any permit under this ordinance for operation or location within any Town street, right-of-way or on residentially zoned properties.

<u>Section V. Penalty.</u> Violation of any section of this ordinance, including any regulations adopted by reference, shall be a petty offense upon a first offense, and, upon a subsequent offense, a Class 3 misdemeanor. Repeat offenders may also be denied any display and/or sale privileges.
