## ORDINANCE 90-A44

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE PARKS AND RECREATION CODE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA:

- Reference: That certain document known as the Town of Camp Verde Parks and Recreation Code, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town Camp Verde, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution 89-92 of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part thereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.
- Section 2. <u>Penalty:</u> Any person found guilty of violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor. Each day that a violation continues shall be punishable as a separate offense.
- Section 3. Severability: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance adopted herein by reference, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
