## ORDINANCE 90-A46

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF HOLDING REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS, AND DECLARING A EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA:

Section 1. Declaration of Regular Council Meetings. Pursuant to ARS 9-233 requiring the fixing of the time and place of regular Town Council meetings by ordinance, it is hereby declared that the Town Council will hold regular meetings on the first and third Wednesdays of each month at the Town Hall, Main Street, Camp Verde, Arizona, beginning at 7:00 p.m. In addition the Town Council will hold a regular meeting strictly for Planning and Zoning matters on the fourth Wednesday of each month at Camp Verde Town Hall, Main Street Camp Verde, Arizona, beginning at 7:00 p.m.

<u>Section 2. Posting.</u> This statement is hereby directed to be filed with the Town Clerk, pursuant to ARs 38-431.02.a.3, and the posting of the public notices of the Town shall be at the bulletin board so provided at Town Hall, together with such further posting or advertising as may be reasonable or practicable as to all meetings, agendas, announcements, or other official notices.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Supersede</u> All prior declarations of the time and place of regular meetings of the Town Council, and posting of notices and official documents, are hereby superseded.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Special Meetings.</u> Special and emergency meetings, as permitted by law, shall be called and posted as regular meetings, by the Mayor or the Town Clerk, after confirmation of the availability of a quorum.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Affidavit.</u> All notices shall contain an affidavit of posting signed by the Town Clerk or a designated representative showing the date and time of posting.
