

CHAPTER 1

Ordinance 87-A18

GENERAL

Article 1-7 Severability of Ordinances

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the council that sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of ordinances shall be severable, and if any provision of an ordinance is held unconstitutional for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of the ordinance.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE:

It being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona and the inhabitants thereof, and that the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary to accomplish these purposes, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval.

PASSED AND ADOPTED BY the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona this 6th day of May, 1987.


