INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

(For Road-Related Services)

WHEREAS the Town of Camp Verde has recently incorporated and has certain obligations to maintain and control the public rights-of-way within the Town limits, and

WHEREAS Yavapai County has the ability to continue to provide certain road-related services for the Town,

IT IS HEREBY AGREED between Yavapai County and the Town of Camp Verde as follows:

- 1. Yavapai County shall process all requests to install culverts or make road cuts for utility installation or repair within the public rights-of-way in the Town of Camp Verde, and perform all necessary field inspections.
- 2. Yavapai County shall review all proposed subdivisions and road construction projects proposed by private parties to determine whether they meet applicable engineering standards. Yavapai County does not assume the responsibility for on-site construction inspections.
- 3. The Town of Camp Verde shall adopt as its own Yavapai County road, culvert and utility standards while this agreement is in effect.
- 4. The Town of Camp Verde shall reimburse Yavapai County for all costs of performing the obligations under this agreement. Any fees collected from applicants shall be paid to the Town directly or used to offset all or portions

of County costs as directed by the Town.

5. This agreement shall have an effective date of July 1, 1987, and shall expire January 1, 1988, and may be terminated at any time by thirty (30) days written notice by either party or renewed for a term mutually agreed to.
