RESOLUTION 88-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE. YAVAPAI COUNTY. ARIZONA. REQUESTING THAT THE YAVAPAI COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADOPT A "TIPPING FEE" FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL IN YAVAPAI COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde's cost to Yavapai County for solid waste disposal has increased from \$29,497 to \$54.480 in a one year period; and

WHEREAS, Yavapai County's population in the Verdo Valley has increased from 21,745 in 1980 to an estimated 33,830 in 1988; and

WHEREAS, tipping tees for solid waste disposar are an ordinary charge nationally and in most counties in Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of "tipping tees" was one of the main recommendations of Yavapai County's alternatives to the Solid Waste Committee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE. YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA:

THAT, the Yavapar County Roard of Supervisors adopt a "tarping fee" system that would charge fees to all compactor and landfill sites within Yavapar County to both residential and commercial users.

THAT, this "tipping tee" revenue be used only to defer the cost of disposing of solid waste and any other waste disposed of at the landtill site and for the establishment of processes of alternative means of solid waste disposal and the future acquisition of landtill sites.

THAT, the Town of Camp Verde requests enforcement aid from Yavapar County to prevent the disposal of solid waste on any area outside the designated landfill site.
