

RESOLUTION 88-52


WHEREAS, NACOG Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Department has successfully administered the EMS Program for the past nine years in Region III; and,

WHEREAS, the NACOG Regional Council and the NACOG Emergency Medical Services Authority Council support the continued operation of the program as it currently exists through a contract with the Arizona Department of Health Services; and,

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Health Services has made the administrative decision to no longer contract with NACOG for these services after September 30, 1988,




