

RESOLUTION 88-70

A RESOLUTION AND PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL REFERENDUM ELECTION HELD ON DECEMBER 13, 1988; AND ORDERING A RECORDING OF SUCH RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Camp Verde, Yavapai County, Arizona by Resolution No. 88-48, adopted on the 29th day of August, 1988, did cause to be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town at a Special Election called and held in and for the Town on the 13th day of December, 1988 for the purpose of deciding Referendum Measure 300; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council did cause notice of the Special Election to be given by the Town Clerk, publishing notice thereof as provided by law, such newspaper published in and having general circulation within said Town, which said notice as so published did specify the polling places, purpose of the election, and other matters required by law; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Yavapai County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said Special Election, as shown by the poll lists was 1,276.


SECTION 2. That the number of questioned ballots was 1, which was later verified as a "no" vote, 4 ballots which were spoiled and that voters found to be ineligible were none.

SECTION 3. That the votes cast for the Referendum were 861 and against were 411.


SECTION 4. That is it hereby found, proclaimed and declared of record, pursuant to ARS Section 19-126.A and the Arizona Constitution, Article 4, Section 1, Part 1(13), that the sales tax ordinance in Referendum Number 300 did receive more than one-half of the total number of valid votes cast; such measure being approved by a majority of those voting thereon, Ordinance 88-A30, so referred, is enacted into law.


