

Resolution 91-136

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MARSHAL TO ENTER INTO A GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS, DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, FOR THE TEMPORARY DETENTION OF PRISONERS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde may provide for jails and houses of correction pursuant to ARS 9-240.B.23, and

WHEREAS, the Town is authorized by ARS 31-121.C to enter into joint agreements for the operation of its jail facilities, and

WHEREAS, ARS 31-122.A directs that provisions be made by United States for support of federal prisoners in State facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Yavapai County, Arizona, that the intergovernmental agreement between the Town and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Truxton Canyon Agency, for the temporary detention of Tribal prisoners be approved, under the terms stated, and effective upon filing with the Yavapai County Recorder pursuant to ARS 11-952.G.


