The following is the Manager's report regarding activities in the month of March 2016:

Verde River RV Resort 260 Sewer

Throughout the month several different staff worked with the developer of the resort park to identify whether or not we could get a gravity line into this property in the timeframe and cost the developer needed. Unfortunately we were not able to get this gravity feed line in at this time and agreed to allow them to move forward with a single source force main to serve them solely. They are working on engineering and right of way that could be helpful in the long run as we pursue development of gravity sewer along 260.

Additionally, we are moving forward with discussion on what mechanisms would be available to fund development of sewer along 260 for future development as well as the mechanism for fairness to existing rate/tax payers. A conference call involved many of the potential staff that would be involved in that future development. Another conference call is necessary to follow up on ideas presented, following that Town staff will be bringing an update to Town Council on this issue and necessary steps to keep this moving.

Budget

Budget was a major focus of the time spent by myself and many other staff and we are trying to tweak the process in an attempt to be more productive with the time spent with Town Council and incorporating a more direct opportunity for citizens to get to ask direct questions of staff. Stay tuned as in May we are working on an open house format which will hopefully allow citizens this opportunity.

Business Licensing

Staff has met again to discuss the revamping of our Business Licensing process. The purpose is to continue to address fairness as well as purpose of this process. Staff will be bringing this issue forward for an update in a work session soon.

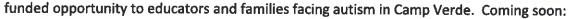
