WHEREAS, the TOWN OF CAMP VERDE strongly opposes splitting our community as proposed; and


WHEREAS, the TOWN OF CAMP VERDE will lose it's elective power as a community; and


WHEREAS, this Resolution represents the Camp Verde proper, Beaver Creek and Lake Montezuma communities; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Yavapai County, Arizona:


