

RESOLUTION 92-175

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA REQUESTING THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO AUTHORIZE TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE FUNDS PURSUANT TO SECTION 28-2602, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES

WHEREAS, the Thirty-fifth Legislature, second special session of 1981, established a Local Transportation Assistance Fund from the proceeds of the Arizona State Lottery; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Arizona Department of Transportation shall determine the total amount of requests for Local Transportation Funds from cities and towns; and

WHEREAS, these funds are to be distributed on a monthly basis by the State Treasurer to cities and towns requesting funds; and

WHEREAS, these funds are to be used for the following purposes:

TRANSPORTATION: Presently combined into HURF for road repairs and improvements

*OTHER To be determined as qualified for cultural, historical or recreation purposes

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA, THAT the Arizona Department of Transportation is hereby requested to take necessary steps in authorizing Local Transportation Assistance Funds for the above mentioned purposes.
