

RESOLUTION 93-211

CALL OF ELECTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, PROVIDING NOTICE OF THE GENERAL ELECTION; PLACING THE QUESTION OF DIRECT ELECTION OF MAYOR BY THE ELECTORATE AS SPECIFIED IN ORDINANCE 92-A77; ESTABLISHING POLLING PLACES, VOTING DISTRICTS, TIMES THAT SUCH POLLS WILL BE OPEN, AND APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICIALS.

WHEREAS, it is provided by law for the holding of a General Election; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council, by resolution, called a General Election to be held on May 18, 1993.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Yavapai County, Arizona as follows:

Section 1: Designation of Election Date

That the Town General Election be held on Tuesday, May 18, 1993 for the purpose of electing candidates for the offices of Council Member and placing the question of direct election of Mayor before the electorate as specified in Ordinance 92-A77.

<u>Verde Lakes:</u>	verde Lakes Clubhouse Verde Lakes

The polls shall be open from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.




