

APPLICATION FOR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE FUNDS

RESOLUTION 93-226

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA, REQUESTING THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO AUTHORIZE TRANSPORTATION FUNDS PURSUANT TO SECTION 28-2602, ARIZONA REVISED STATUES.

WHEREAS, the Thirty-fifth Legislature, second special session of 1981, established a Local Transportation Assistance Fund from the proceeds of the Arizona State Lottery; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Arizona Department of Transportation shall determine the total amount of request for Local Transportation Funds from Cities and Towns; and

WHEREAS, these funds are to be distributed on a monthly basis by the State Treasurer to cities and towns requesting funds; and


WHEREAS, these funds are to be used for the following purposes:

TRANSPORTATION: ROAD/STREET IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIRS

OTHER: TO BE DETERMINED AS QUALIFIED PER ARS 28-2603

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA, THAT the Arizona Department of Transportation if hereby requested to take necessary steps in authorizing Local Transportation Assistant Funds for the above-mentioned purposes.
