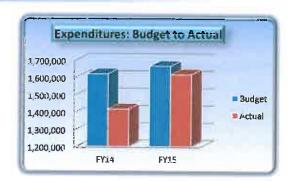

Our monthly newslotter DECEMBER 2015 Arians family legacy extends beyong the football field

Thousands of children get caught up in the court and foster systems, bouncing from place to place, without somewhere to really call home. According to Christine Arians, it's a serious problem, especially in our community.

"We still have over in this county, over thirteen

thousand kids in out of home care—a lot of whom are in group homes-think of an old fashioned orphanage; that's all a group home is," she said.

And helping those thousands of children find a permanent home has become a permanent mission for the entire Arians family.

Arizona Cardinals Head Coach Bruce Arians and his wife Chris say, they knew as soon as they arrived in Arizona they had to do something.

"When we moved here, he said, 'this is our chance.' Now, we have a recognizable face and a voice that people will listen to. Let's form a foundation and let's support CASA," she told 12 News.

CASA, which stands for Court Appointed Special Advocate, is a court run organization. At times CASA has had a hard time getting the word out about the work it does helping kids. That's when the Arians Family foundation stepped up, continuing the work Chris has been silently, but diligently, been doing for about 30 years.



"We've seen what's she's done behind the scenes. You can't help them all but we can start with one kid at a time," said Jake Arians, son of head coach Bruce and president of the Arians Family Foundation.

So began 'VOICES for CASA' a sidebar organization created to promote the value of CASA. Volunteers stay with each case until it's closed and the child is placed in a safe, permanent home.

For many abused children, their CASA volunteer is the one constant adult in their lives. "It's shocking," Jake said. "We moved to this community just over two years ago and the number is up something like 40%, how many kids are in the system."

The Arians' goal is to spread the word and get

The Arians' goal is to spread the word and get more people to become volunteers for CASA. It's a commitment this family has made to Arizona's future, which extends well beyond the football field.

"I would love an endowment big enough that it lasts forever," Jake said. "That would be about the coolest legacy you can leave your mom."
