A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE CONCEPT OF A TRAIL SYSTEM WITHIN YAVAPAI COUNTY, TO INCLUDE THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA.

- WHEREAS, the Yavapai Trails Association is developing a system of inter-connecting trails for hikers, horse riders, bicyclists and other users throughout Yavapai County; and
- WHEREAS, the Yavapai Trails Association is fostering cooperation and communication among all trail users' groups; and
- WHEREAS, the Yavapai trails Association is promoting communication and cooperation with all government agencies regarding trails; and
- WHEREAS, the Yavapai Trails Association is creating higher visibility for trail opportunities and issues; and
- WHEREAS, the Yavapai Trails Association seeks the development of new trail resources; and
- WHEREAS, the development of a multiple-use trail system for all users will benefit the citizens of Camp Verde, and Yavapai Couty and foster cooperation among all users; and
- WHEREAS, recreational trails not only provide an opportunity for healthy outdoor exercise and experiences, but serve as an alternate means of transportation; and
- WHEREAS, without a trail network we will rapidly lose existing trails to development, as well as access to public lands.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA, THAT THE EFFORTS OF THE YAVAPAI TRAILS ASSOCIATION PROMOTING THE CONCEPT OF A TRAIL SYSTEM WITHIN YAVAPAI COUNTY, TO INCLUDE THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA, IS HEREBY SUPPORTED AND AFFIRMED.
