

RESOLUTION NO. 94-264


A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE CONCEPT OF A TRAIL SYSTEM WITHIN YAVAPAI COUNTY, TO INCLUDE THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA.

- WHEREAS,** *the Yavapai Trails Association is developing a system of inter-connecting trails for hikers, horse riders, bicyclists and other users throughout Yavapai County; and*
- WHEREAS,** *the Yavapai Trails Association is fostering cooperation and communication among all trail users' groups; and*
- WHEREAS,** *the Yavapai trails Association is promoting communication and cooperation with all government agencies regarding trails; and*
- WHEREAS,** *the Yavapai Trails Association is creating higher visibility for trail opportunities and issues; and*
- WHEREAS,** *the Yavapai Trails Association seeks the development of new trail resources; and*
- WHEREAS,** *the development of a multiple-use trail system for all users will benefit the citizens of Camp Verde, and Yavapai County and foster cooperation among all users; and*
- WHEREAS,** *recreational trails not only provide an opportunity for healthy outdoor exercise and experiences, but serve as an alternate means of transportation; and*
- WHEREAS,** *without a trail network we will rapidly lose existing trails to development, as well as access to public lands.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA, THAT THE EFFORTS OF THE YAVAPAI TRAILS ASSOCIATION PROMOTING THE CONCEPT OF A TRAIL SYSTEM WITHIN YAVAPAI COUNTY, TO INCLUDE THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA, IS HEREBY SUPPORTED AND AFFIRMED.
