RESOLUTION 94-270

A RESOLUTION OF MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPOINTING A MAGISTRATE PRO TEMPORE

WHEREAS, the Town has the authority pursuant to ARS 9-240.B.28 and 22-402 to establish a magistrate or police court, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 87-A07, Section 5-2-1 provides for appointment by Council of the Town Magistrate, and

WHEREAS, the Town Magistrate has requested that the Council consider the appointment of a magistrate pro tempore to act in the absence or disqualification of the Magistrate as provided by law, and has nominated an appointee,

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Appointment of Magistrate Pro Tempore. The Town hereby appoints William "Tip" Roberts, Magistrate for the City of Sedona, as magistrate pro tempore for the Town of Camp Verde, with all duties and responsibilities as magistrate pursuant to ARS 22-402 and 22-121.C (as amended).
- 2. Duration. This appointment shall be for a period of time not to exceed six (6) months, and may extend beyond the term for the purpose of hearing and determining any proceeding necessary for a final determination of a cause heard by him in whole or in part during the period of his appointment. The appointment may be terminated at any time by written order of the Town Magistrate. This appointment may also be renewed by written order of the Magistrate for additional 6-month terms pursuant to ARS 22-121.B.
- 3. Expenses. The Town shall compensate the magistrate *pro tempore* and pay any expenses associated with the performance of his duties for the Town as may be requested.
