**A RESOLUTION OF MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA,
APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENTS WITH THE OFFICE OF MANUFACTURED HOUSING
FOR INSTALLATION INSPECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde, a municipal corporation ("Town") has adopted the Uniform Building Code and established the office of Building Inspector for its enforcement, and


WHEREAS, the Office of Manufactured Housing, Arizona Department of Building and Fire Safety, has proposed that a local building or zoning inspector be designated to enforce installation inspections of manufactured homes and factory-built buildings to avoid duplication of inspections and reduce administrative costs, as set out in an intergovernmental agreement as A.G. Contract No. OMH _____ and _____, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Camp Verde would be better served by a more prompt installation inspection by local governmental agents,

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to ARS 11-952.H, the Town is authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreements with the Office of Manufactured Housing, Arizona Department of Building and Fire Safety, being contracts A.G. Contract No. OMH _____ and _____, dated September __, 1994, for performing all necessary installation inspections required by OMH for manufactured housing and factory-built buildings within the municipal limits of the Town.


