

**RESOLUTION 94-279**

**A RESOLUTION OF MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA,  
APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL  
AGREEMENT WITH THE CENSUS BUREAU FOR A 1995 SPECIAL CENSUS**

*WHEREAS*, the Town of Camp Verde, a municipal corporation ("Town") must update its population estimates in 1995 for its share of state sales tax, highway, and lottery revenues for the period July 1, 1996 through July 1, 2001, and

*WHEREAS*, the Bureau of the Census, U.S. Department of Commerce, has proposed an intergovernmental agreement with the Town and the adjoining municipalities to share in the cost of a special census, estimated at approximately \$60,000, with the share of the Town of Camp Verde to be 42.4% based on relative populations of the communities in the 1990 census, and

*WHEREAS*, the citizens of Camp Verde would be better served by a special census rather than a contract with Arizona Department of Economic Security for a community survey,


**NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN  
OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Pursuant to ARS 11-952.H**, the Town is authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement with the Bureau of the Census, U.S. Department of Commerce, designated as contract number \_\_\_\_\_, issue the Town's share of the initial payment to the Census Bureau, and that such agreement be signed by the Mayor on behalf of the Town, provided the remaining Verde Valley communities likewise execute the IGA and provide the necessary funds.
