

RESOLUTION 94-284

**A RESOLUTION OF MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA,
APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT WITH YAVAPAI COUNTY FLEET MANAGEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde ("Town") has a need to have available a motor vehicle fuel supply, particularly for emergency and police vehicles, at the lowest possible cost, and

WHEREAS, Yavapai County Fleet Management ("County") operates a fuel depot and pumping station at its Cherry Creek facilities, and has offered to enroll the Town vehicles in its bulk fuel contract, at a cost and under the conditions of the attached intergovernmental agreement,

WHEREAS, the citizens of Camp Verde would be better served by participating with the County in the fleet fuel contract to save costs and have available a pumping station in the Cherry Creek area on a 24-hour basis,


**NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN

Pursuant to ARS 11-952.H, the Town is authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement with Yavapai County Fleet Management, and any renewals, and that such agreement be signed by the Mayor on behalf of the Town.
