

RESOLUTION 95-301

**A RESOLUTION OF MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA,
DECLARING A PUBLIC EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, there has occurred widespread flooding of rivers and surface waters within the limits of the Town due to unusual weather conditions and storms beginning March 5, 1995, and

WHEREAS, the flooding has caused damage to roads, structures, water systems, public facilities and forced emergency evacuation and utilization of emergency services, and

WHEREAS, restoration of services, monitoring of water supplies and abatement of health hazards may require the combined efforts of services and personnel of the Town, state and federal disaster relief resources, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is authorized pursuant to ARS 26-311 to declare an emergency, govern by proclamation, and impose all necessary regulations to preserve the peace and order of the incorporated boundaries of the Town, and to thereby authorize expenditure of emergency and disaster relief funds, equipment, and personnel, and to make requests to other governmental agencies for disaster relief, and


WHEREAS, it is necessary to adopt this resolution as an emergency measure,

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY DUE TO RIVER AND SURFACE FLOODING, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO COORDINATE OR SOLICIT ALL DISASTER RELIEF SERVICES AND MAKE SUCH FURTHER PROCLAMATIONS AS PERMITTED BY LAW.

PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Yavapai County, Arizona on the 8th day of March, 1995.
