## RESOLUTION TO CANVASS VOTE

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 14, 1995; AND ORDERING THE RECORDING OF SUCH RESOLUTION.
