A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA INDICATING SUPPORT FOR CONTINUED FUNDING FOR THE RC&D PROGRAM

WHEREAS, RC&D is a small federal program that has a large positive impact on Rural American and Rural Arizona;

WHEREAS, Arizona's five RC&D Areas utilize local volunteers to direct a USDA rural development program to control their own destiny;

WHEREAS, local RC&D Councils utilize federal support to implement projects that emphasize land conservation, community development, water management and environmental protection;

WHEREAS, local people in the area are best able to determine needs and create solutions for their community and the strength of RC&D is in the commitment of people to solve their own problems;

WHEREAS, the majority of Arizona's counties and towns including the Town of Camp Verde benefit from the RC&D program;

WHEREAS, RC&D Councils leverage RC&D funds with other federal, state, local and private funds to implement projects at a ratio of about \$14.00 for every USDA dollar spent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, support continued funding for the RC&D program at or above the current level to maintain our effectiveness in supporting the economy and resources of rural Arizona.
