ACCEPTING THE COPS FAST GRANT**



*WHEREAS*, the Town has been notified by COPS that it has been selected to receive a grant to hire one (1) new officer under the terms of the grant, including 25% matching funds from the Town, in accordance with the Budget Information Fact Sheet, dated March 9, 1995, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference,



**Pursuant to ARS 11-952.H**, the Town is authorized to execute the COPS grant beginning March 1, 1995, with the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, and participate according to the terms of the grant, including the Town's share of the funding.
