**A RESOLUTION OF MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA,  
TO SUPPORT THE SECTION 404 PERMIT APPLICATION  
OF HENRY SHILL ON WEST CLEAR CREEK**


*WHEREAS*, Henry Shill has submitted an application to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to re-establish flood protection for farmland adjacent to West Clear Creek under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1344), and

*WHEREAS*, the proposed activity will be to repair an existing dike and remove approximately 4,000 cubic yards of gravel bar materials which have accumulated near the Verde River confluence that causes the creek channel to impact the dike and other property, and to stockpile the removed material on private property outside the creek area, which is not a commercial activity, and


*WHEREAS*, pursuant to Section 232.3(c)(2), Code of Federal Regulations, maintenance and emergency reconstruction of recently damaged dikes is an activity which normally does not require a Section 404 permit,

**NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE TO SUPPORT THE SECTION 404 APPLICATION.**
