

RESOLUTION 97-388

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CAMP VERDE FIRE DISTRICT FOR DISPATCH SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Fire District requires professional telephone dispatching services which can be provided by the Town through the Marshal's Office, and

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated the terms of a dispatching agreement, including fees and response times, pursuant to their respective authority under ARS 9-240.7(a) and 48-805.B.8, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ARS 11-952.H action is required by ordinance or resolution of each governing body before an intergovernmental agreement can become effective,

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE TO ENTER INTO THE PROPOSED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CAMP VERDE FIRE DISTRICT FOR DISPATCH SERVICES DATED JULY 1, 1997, AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXECUTION BY THE MAYOR, INCLUDING ANY EXTENSIONS OR RENEWALS.
