A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF PROJECTS FOR CONSIDERATION IN ARIZONA'S 1998/99 HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety is seeking proposals from state and local jurisdictions for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety; and


WHEREAS; the Town of Camp Verde, through the Marshal's Office, is interested in submitting projects to be considered for funding in the form of reimbursable grants from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and the Federal Highway Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. THAT approval of the filing of projects for consideration in Arizona's 1998/99 Highway Safety Plan is grants.

Section II. THAT John Wischmeyer, Marshal, is appointed for the Town of Camp Verde to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments concerning such grant.


