

RESOLUTION 98-408

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AN EXTENSION OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH BIA FOR TELEPHONE DISPATCHING SERVICES, AND INCLUDING DISPATCHING FOR THE YAVAPAI-APACHE NATION


WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde ("Town") and Truxton Canyon Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs ("Agency"), entered into an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) on October 1, 1997, for payment to the Town for dispatching services, and approved of the agreement in Resolution 97-384, and

WHEREAS, the IGA provided for an initial term of one year, ending September 30, 1998, which may be extended or renewed by the parties, and termination by either party with a written 60-day notice, and


WHEREAS, the Town and the Agency wish to extend the IGA for an additional 1-year term, with the same payment, and to now also include telephone dispatching for the tribal police of the Yavapai-Apache Nation,

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE TO EXTEND FOR AN ADDITIONAL YEAR THE DISPATCHING IGA WITH BIA, AND TO INCLUDE TELEPHONE DISPATCHING SERVICES FOR THE TRIBAL POLICE OF THE YAVAPAI-APACHE NATION IN THE SAME FEE AND UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE ORIGINAL IGA:


