A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF PROJECTS FOR CONSIDERATION IN ARIZONA'S 1999 HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety is seeking proposals from state and local jurisdictions for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde, through the Marshal's Office, is interested in submitting projects to be considered for funding in the form of reimbursable grants from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the Federal Highway Administration,

- 1. That approval of the filing of projects for consideration in Arizona's 1999 Highway Safety Plan is granted.
- 2. That John Wischmeyer, Town Marshal, is appointed agent for the Town to conduct negotiations and execute all documents and instruments in connection with such grant.
