- 1. The total number of ballots cast at the General Election, as shown on the poll lists, were 1,618, and the total number of registered voters in the Town was 4,663, for a turnout of 34.70%.
- 2. There were 16 ballots to be verified, six voters were found to be ineligible, and six ballots rejected.
