WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde, an Arizona municipal corporation ("Town"), has adopted the Uniform Building Code and related enforcement procedures, and created the office of building inspector and code enforcement officers, and

WHEREAS, the Office of Manufactured Housing, Arizona Department of Building and Fire Safety, has proposed that a local building or zoning inspector be designated to enforce installation inspections of manufactured homes and factory-built buildings to avoid duplication of inspections and reduce administrative costs, as set out in an intergovernmental agreement as A.G. Contract No. _____, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Camp Verde would be better served by a more prompt installation inspection by local governmental agents, and the proposed agreement to retain inspection fees set by the codes are a fair compensation for the services by the Town,

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Contract No. OMH	, and the Mayor is authorized to execute the
agreement on behalf of the Town.
