A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE PUBLIC AGENCIES IN THE PUBLIC SAFETY CONSORTIUM

WHEREAS, two or more public agencies, as defined by ARS 11-951, including a municipality or Indian tribe, may pursuant to ARS 11-952 (1997), through a written and recorded agreement, contract for services, jointly exercise any powers common to the contracting parties, or provide for joint or cooperative actions, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has reviewed the proposed intergovernmental agreement for participation in the Public Safety Consortium for an automated criminal history records exchange using the Spillman computer data system, and determined that the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Camp Verde is furthered by its approval,

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE, PURSUANT TO ARS 11-952.H, TO EXECUTE THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE PUBLIC SAFETY CONSORTIUM, EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2000, FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONSORTIUM ACCORDING TO ITS TERMS, INCLUDING ANNUAL SHARE OF SOFTWARE EXPENSES, TRAINING, AND REQUIREMENTS OF ANY GRANT ADMINISTRATION.
