A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF PROJECTS FOR CONSIDERATION IN ARIZONA'S 2003 SAFETY PLAN:

*WHEREAS*, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety is seeking proposals from state and local agencies for projects to all aspects of highway safety; and


*WHEREAS*, the Town of Camp Verde, through the Marshal's Office, is interested in submitting projects to be considered for funding in the form of reimbursable grants from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration;


1. THAT approval of the submission of projects for consideration in Arizona's 2003 fiscal year Highway Safety Plan is granted.
