
A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, TO APPLY FOR THE COPS UNIVERSAL HIRING PROGRAM 2002

WHEREAS, through the program the U.S. Department of Justice has established the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) to expedite the hiring of new police officers and to implement Community policing programs, and

WHEREAS, the Camp Verde Marshal's Office has completed a grant application under the COPS UHP 2002 program to fund an entry-level officer position in the amount of \$126,116 with a local match of \$53,086 to include salary and benefits for three years, with the Town being required to retain the position for at least one locally funded budget cycle after the grant ends,


NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE TO SUBMIT THE APPLICATION UNDER THE COPS UHP 2002 PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXECUTION BY THE TOWN MARSHAL AND MAYOR.


