

### **RESOLUTION 2002-528**

# A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION OF THE TOWN HELD ON SEPTEMBER 10, 2002

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde ("Town"), held a Special Election on September 10, 2002 for Propositions 401 and 402 and the recall of Council Member Eric Eberhard; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented by the Yavapai County Elections Department have been canvassed by the Town Council,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Yavapai County, Arizona, pursuant to A.R.S. §16-646 and 9-821.01:

- 1. The total number of ballots cast at the Special Election, as shown on the poll lists, were 1639 and the total number of registered voters in the Town was 3256, for a turnout of 50.33%.
- 2. There were 7 ballots to be verified, one voter was found to be ineligible, and one ballot rejected.
- 3. The number of votes cast were as follows:
