**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA,
APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF THE STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE
AND CAMP VERDE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde ("Town") and the Camp Verde Unified School District (CVUSD) wish to continue a working relationship to provide for emergency evacuation to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Town and CVUSD desire to enter into a Statement of Understanding that will serve the health, safety, and welfare of the community by preparing for emergency evacuation of CVUSD students and staff;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Common Council of the Town resolve to enter into a Statement of Understanding with the Camp Verde Unified School District as presented and approved by the Council at the Regular Session of October 16, 2002.

**STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
CAMP VERDE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
AND**

The purpose of this Statement of Understanding (SOU) is to continue the working relationship between Camp Verde Unified School District (hereinafter referred to as CVUSD) and TOWN OF CAMP VERDE in preparing for emergency evacuation of CVUSD students and staff. This agreement provides a broad framework for cooperation between the two entities.

Each party to this SOU is a separate and independent entity. As such, each entity retains its own identity in providing service and is responsible for establishing its own policies and financing its own activities.

This SOU allows CVUSD to use CAMP VERDE COMMUNITY CENTER facility if an emergency evacuation is imminent. Close liaison will be maintained between CVUSD and the facility being used. CVUSD will remain responsible for all students and staff while they remain in the facility being used.

Representatives of CVUSD and TOWN OF CAMP VERDE will, on an annual basis, on or around the anniversary date of this agreement, jointly evaluate the SOU and revise and develop new plans or goals as seen appropriate.

This SOU shall be effective on October 16, 2002 and last five years. Six months prior to the expiration date, the parties shall meet to review the progress and success of the SOU and determine whether it shall be extended for an additional five years. It is understood by both parties that, at any time, this Statement of Understanding may be terminated by written notification from either party to the other.

This Statement of Understanding does not create a partnership or joint venture, and neither party has the authority to bind the other.
