**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL  
OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA,  
ADOPTING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH  
YAVAPAI COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT  
FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR RESTORATION OF WEST CLEAR CREEK**

**WHEREAS**, two or more public agencies, as defined by ARS §11-951, including a municipality or a special taxing district, may pursuant to ARS §11-952, through a written and recorded agreement, contract for services, jointly exercise any powers common to the contracting parties, or provide for joint or cooperative actions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Common Council has reviewed the proposed intergovernmental agreement for financial assistance in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to fund a study in the Verde Lakes/West Clear Creek area.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde resolve, pursuant to ARS §11-951.H, to execute the intergovernmental agreement with Yavapai County dated August 21, 2002, to fund a study to address restoration of West Clear Creek to its historic channel and to allow for its annual renewal by motion as provided therein. Passed and adopted by a majority voted of the Common Council at the Regular Session of August 21, 2002.


