



RESOLUTION No. 2002-540

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON CONCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OTHER NORTHERN ARIZONA COMMUNITIES THROUGH THEIR ELECTED GOVERNING BOARDS TO CAUSE THE ADVANCEMENT OF OUR COLLECTIVE WATER RESOURCE INTERESTS THROUGH THE FORMATION OF THE NORTHERN ARIZONA MUNICIPAL WATER USERS ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, the governmental entities of Northern Arizona are tasked with ensuring their citizens with water resources and,

WHEREAS, to maintain the economic vitality of Northern Arizona, water must be readily available and,

WHEREAS, the regulatory and physical challenges faced by individual water providers are formidable and,

WHEREAS, a partnership amount communities of Northern Arizona that have not received the benefit of substantial Federal or State dollars to assist with water resource acquisition or infrastructure is valuable.

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

That the formation of the Northern Arizona Municipal Water Users Association (NAMUWA) be effective within 30 days of the passage of this resolution.

That NAMWUA adopt goals and objectives consistent with the interests expressed by the member communities as it relates to the acquisition and delivery of water.

That the member communities adopt by laws consistent with the appropriate governance required for said voluntary organization.
