

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, EXTENDING THE TERMS OF THE SITTING MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS TO COMPLY WITH ARS §16-204, AS AMENDED, RELATED TO CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, The Arizona State Legislature in 2012 amended ARS§16-204 to consolidated all regular candidate elections including those of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona to the fall of even numbered years; and

WHEREAS, the amendments to §16-204consolidate elections beginning in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Governor Jan Brewer signed SB1454 allowing municipalities to only extend terms of elected officials; and

WHEREAS, because of the consolidated elections, the Town of Camp Verde cannot hold elections at the end of the terms of the current Mayor and Council members; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the consolidation of elections, the Town must adjust the length of terms of the Mayor and members of the Town Council currently so that their terms will expire following the General Election in November of even numbered years;

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona, that:

- 1. The term of Mayor Charles German will expire when his successor assumes office following the 2016 General Election.
- 2. The terms of those Council Members (Jessie Jones, Carol German, & Bruce George) whose terms expire in the spring of 2015 will be extended to when their successors assume office following the 2016 General Election.
- 3. The terms of those Council Members (Jackie Baker, Robin Whatley, and Bradford Gordon) whose terms expire in the spring of 2017 will be extended to when their successors assume office following the 2018 General Election.
